B.Voc. (Software Development)

About the course:

B.voc (Software Development) course was started in year 2018 under P.G. Department of Computer Science. B.Voc. course is introduced with an aim to incorporate requirements of various industries into its curriculum. Vocational or skill-based education is becoming more and more significant with passing time. B.Voc (Bachelor of Vocation) is an emerging course in India that aims at providing adequate skills required for a particular trade to candidates. The course is different from traditional academic programmes as it **deals more with application-based studies** rather than focusing on only theoretical knowledge. The course helps ensure students have adequate skills, make them **work ready**, enhance employability of graduates, and thus make them part of global workforce. The curriculum offers a unique **blend of vocational and business management** concepts. Field visits, internships, guest lecturers from industry experts, experimental learning are some of the highlights of this curriculum.

- One of the biggest **advantages** of pursuing B.Voc against common degree courses is that a candidate has multiple exit points during the programme and continued industry exposure.
- This means that if a candidate is unable to complete her B.Voc course, she has still **awarded a diploma** after successful completion of first year or advanced diploma after successful completion of second year. Apart from this, the work experience candidates gain during the course increases their chances of getting a job.
