

DEAN STUDENT'S WELFARE

The College follows the philosophy of Guru Nanak's teachings which believes that the institution should have the social responsibility towards the underprivileged, downtrodden and marginalized section of the society which will be helpful to create an egalitarian society. In light of this the college has assigned Dean Student's Welfare Duty to Dr. Bali Bahadur and formally set up an office of Dean Student's Welfare which guide and assists students requiring financial support in the form of fee concession and scholarships from the college and other funding agencies.

The Dean Student's Welfare assists SC/ST/OBC and minority candidates in case of problems faced in getting the necessary forms completed and attested. The main activity of this office is to find out funding agencies that can support financially to the students and fill their scholarships forms of different categories of the students and send them to different national and international funding agencies for financial assistance. Whatsoever financial assistance the college receives from the Centre Govt. / State Govt. and other agencies, the college also adds its own fund to it.
