#### **Enrollment**:

- 1. In the beginning of Academic Year, primary selection is done on volunteer basis.
- 2. Final selection is done by considering Height, Weight, and Physical fitness followed by a medical Examination.
- 3. Enrollment fees and PTA fund is taken from Cadets and is deposited to Unit as per rules.

#### NCC Training:

NCC training of cadets is carried out in two parts as Institutional Training and Camp Training. Institutional training is given by ANO/CTO with the help of appointed PI staff of NCC Unit.
