Name of the Institution : Guru Nanak College for Girls

3. Innovation in Curricular Design and Transaction

Though the curriculum is designed and revised by the Panjab University, Chandigarh, for effective curriculum delivery, the college has many innovative and enriched Value Added

Courses such as Journalism, Fashion Designing, Computer application and Spoken English. In addition to this, keeping in view the local needs, the curriculum of various short term courses such as Cutting and stitching, Machine embroidery, printing and dyeing, food preservatives, English speaking and basics of computer science are designed, executed and evaluated by the concerned faculty members.

Also, one gym with physical education department and one fully air conditioned seminar hall with projector, display screen and audio system has been constructed in the basement. With the starting of new course, that is, B.Sc (Medical), new science labs were also created.

College has created its first aid room where female doctor visits on regular basis. The college has designated one faculty member to take students to the hospital in case of emergency. Also, the college students are covered under group insurance scheme of LIC students can get compensation at the time of need as per the terms and conditions of the scheme. The Diet Counseling Cell created by the home science department aware the students about the health related problems, nutritious diet etc. Various lectures are also arranged for the students. Red Ribbon Club of the college aware the students about dangerous diseases like AIDS, Cancer etc. Further, the departments arrange lectures and camps at their own level. The department of commerce and economics organized an eye check-up camp for the students during this year.

Kabaddi team won second place in Inter College Kabaddi tournament held at Punjab University, Chandigarh from 7th-10th November, 2011. Moreover, four players of the college represented Panjab university in All India Inter University Kabaddi Championship held at Kanya Kumari from 15th -18th January, 2012 and in All India North-East Inter University held at Orissa from 22nd -26th December, 2011 and won second place in the tournament.

- **Volleyball**

Six players of the college represented Muktsar district in Women Festival held at Bathinda from 11th-14th October, 2011 and won first place and in 16th Junior State Championship held at Moga from 5th-7th September, 2011 where also they won first place. Similarly, one player of the college represented Panjab University in all India Inter University Volley Ball Tournament held at Kerala.
